



Concurrent Enrollment Nursing Pipeline - Frequently Asked Question

How does the pipeline work?

Students have two options for enrollment:

1. Complete CENP courses **prior** to beginning to the BHC Nursing program.
 - a. Upon successful completion of at least one of the TTUHSC El Paso CENP courses, students receive preferential review for admission to the BHC nursing program.
 - b. To be eligible for admission, students must submit an official transcript from TTUHSC EP showing the grades earned for the CENP courses. These should be submitted with your application to the BHC Nursing program.
2. Complete CENP courses **during** the BHC Nursing program.
 - a. Upon completion of the ADN program, students are guaranteed* admission into the TTUHSC El Paso RN to BSN program.

Students who complete both of the CENP courses offered through TTUHSC EP GGHSON may be eligible to graduate in as little as 2 semesters after graduating from BHC ADN program!

When can I enroll into the CENP? When can I take these CENP classes?

The TTUHSC El Paso CENP admits every Spring, Summer, and Fall term.

Do I have to take both courses in the same semester?

No. Students have the option to enroll in the two CENP courses in the same semester, or may take one course in one term, and the second course in the subsequent term.

Can I use my financial aid?

Unfortunately, CENP students are not eligible to use financial aid at the TTUHSC El Paso while they are completing CENP courses. This is because CENP students are considered 'non-degree seeking' **until** they're fully admitted into the RN to BSN program, after graduation from the BHC ADN program, and have obtained their nursing license. CENP students will be automatically transferred into the TTUHSC El Paso GGHSON RN to BSN program immediately after graduation from the Brookhaven College ADN program. Once fully admitted to the RN to BSN program, students may use financial aid, if they qualify.

How much will the courses cost?

The estimated cost for 6 credit hours in the CENP is \$2,576 for In-State tuition. More information can be found at:
