BS DEGREE WITH A MAJOR IN NURSING

Stony Brook's highly competitive, pre-licensure undergraduate nursing programs combine coursework with simulation and clinical experience. Stony Brook University Hospital is utilized as a clinical site along with various other settings. Students engage in experiential learning opportunities that focus on the individual, families and populations across the health care continuum. Graduates of the programs are eligible to sit for the NCLEX-RN exam.

The Accelerated Nursing Program (on-site) is designed for students who have already completed a bachelor's degree, either at the State University of New York at Stony Brook or another comparable institution. This twelve month concentrated nursing program leads to a Bachelor of Science degree with a major in Nursing.

The Basic Baccalaureate Nursing Program (on-site) leads to a Bachelor of Science degree with a major in Nursing. Students begin this two year, upper division nursing program after completing preadmission, general education coursework (either at Stony Brook University or another accredited institution). The nursing major applies principles from the sciences, art and humanities to patient-centered nursing practice.

The School of Nursing requires the completion of three pre-admission sciences upon uploading transcripts and submitting the application prior to the application deadline date. Any outstanding pre-admission course work will become a condition for admission and must be completed with transcripts submitted and evaluated prior to the first day of classes.

All course work evaluated for transfer must be completed with a grade of C or higher. A grade of C- and below is not eligible for transfer.

Advanced Placement as well as CLEP are transferable, depending upon the score.
