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### **NURSING ACADEMIC ADVISOR GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS:**

- ALL students who are missing or are currently taking any PCI courses, are NOT qualified to apply for the HESI A2 Nursing Admission Test. Please note, there is now a fee to apply to take the exam.
- Students must take the HESI A2 Nursing Admission Test at the College and the HESI scores from other nursing schools will not be accepted. This examination may be taken for a maximum of two times but NOT in the same semester. Students are strongly encouraged to complete Anatomy & Physiology II (BIO 426) before taking the HESI A2 Nursing Admission Test because the Science content is an important portion of the exam. However, the student can take the exam if they meet the basic PCI requirements.
- Students who have transfer credits in any of the nursing pre-requisites & additional nursing courses, they **must submit an unofficial copy of their transcript** with this checklist. The transcript MUST show grades and the term/semester courses were taken. **Please note the science courses cannot be more than 5 years old. \*CHE 121, BIO 425,426 and 420)**
- All students applying to the Nursing Program must complete this checklist and submit it to the Nursing Academic Advisor's mailbox in S730 by deadline:
  - **SPRING ADMISSION DEADLINE: NOVEMBER 15<sup>th</sup> HESI A2 Nursing Admission Test in December**
  - **FALL ADMISSION DEADLINE: MAY 1<sup>st</sup> HESI A2 Nursing Admission Test in May**
